Mr. Roy, learned advocate representing the petitioners by placing before this Court the communication dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2025 would submit that the issues raised in the writ petition has since been resolved on the basis of an undertaking executed by the respondent no.13. 4. Mr. Ray, learned senior advocate appears on behalf of the respondent nos. 5 and 6 and does not object to the prayer for withdrawal of the writ petition.
5. Heard the learned advocates appearing for the respective parties. Since the petitioners do not want to proceed with the writ petition and seek leave to withdraw the same, let the writ petition be dismissed as withdrawn.
6. Interim order passed on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 stands vacated.
7. Let it be recorded that since in the orders dated 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 and 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 the appearance of Mr. P. K. Ray, learned senior advocate representing the respondent nos. 5 and 6 has not been recorded, let the aforesaid orders be corrected by incorporating the name of Mr. P. K. Ray, learned senior advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent nos. 5 and 6.
8. Department is directed to carry out the aforesaid corrections in the orders dated 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 and 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2025.
