**C.R.M. (M) 1502 of 2025**

In Re : An application for bail under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 filed in connection with Chinsurah PS Case No. 398 of 2024 dated 16.09.2024 under Sections 103(1)/115(2)/61(2)/3(5) of the BNS. 2023.

And

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody for more than a year and seeks parity with co-accused Baban Singh who has been granted bail by this Court earlier.

Learned counsel for the State does not oppose the said fact.

I have considered the material on record. Allegation against the petitioner is omnibus. No specific role has been attributed to him by the witnesses.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is similarly circumstanced with the co accused who has been granted bail earlier, he deserves the same benefit.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioner namely **Shyam Sundar Shaw** be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hooghly subject to condition that he shall appear before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing fixed by the learned trial Court. He shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the learned trial Court on any date without justifiable cause, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
