1. Petitioners complain that they are not being allowed by the private respondents to use the wash room. Petitioners are aged and parents of the private respondents.

Having considered the nature of dispute complained of, I direct in case any application is preferred before the Maintenance Tribunal under the relevant provisions of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, SDO would promptly pass direction having considered the nature of the dispute complained of. In case any direction is passed and police authority's assistance be sought for, Police authorities would act in consonance with the direction passed by the Maintenance Tribunal.
4. With the aforesaid observation WPA 20569 of 2025 is disposed of.
