This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Bishnupur, Bankura to dispose of Title Suit No. 32 of 2016 expeditiously.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the suit is otherwise ready for hearing.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties.
