CRM (NDPS) 1086 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kaliachak Police Station case no. 1447 of 2024 dated 13.09.2024 under Sections 21(c)/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 read with Section 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner surrendered before the learned trial Court on 08.07.2025 since then he is in custody.

On the other hand learned advocate appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the recovery was 3.476 kgs of brown sugar. Although, the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused but on the relevant period there are call detail records to show that with the wife of the principal accused the petitioner was communicating. It has been submitted that the petitioner has antecedents.

Having considered the locus of the present petitioner in respect of the present case as well as the stage of the present

case, I direct the learned trial Court to release the petitioner on bail after the stage of consideration of charges is over subject to such terms and conditions as learned Special Court deems fit and proper for ensuring the presence of the present petitioner.

With the aforesaid directions CRM (NDPS) No. 1086 of 2025 is **disposed of**.
