In Re : An application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 filed in connection with English Bazar Police Station Case No.1161 of 2023 dated 22.07.2023 under Sections 489B/489C/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

The petitioners are in custody for more than 2 years and renew their prayer for bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite a direction of this Court, trial is yet to be concluded.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that prosecution proposes to examine 11 witnesses out of whom 8 witnesses have been examined. The remaining witnesses shall be examined within two months from the next date of evidence fixed before the learned trial Court.

On merits, the petitioners do not deserve a favourable order at this stage.

Prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of

the parties, in the light of the submission made on behalf of the State.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
