Petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that the
information which was furnished on or about
14.05.2025 with Netaji Nagar Police Station was not

being referred to Anti-Cheating and Fraud Cell,
Detective Department, Lalbazar, I direct the
complaint of the petitioner be also referred to the
Officer-in-Charge of the concerned department. The

cognizable offence is made out and thereafter take a
decision whether to proceed with the complaint or
not.
