In re: An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 read with Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Jamuria** Police Station Case No. **242** of **2022** dated **18.05.2022** under Sections **307** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, adding section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with sections 25/27 of the Arms Act.

Petitioner is in custody for 2 years and 8 months.

Trial is in progress.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that five further prosecution witnesses are likely to be examined at the trial.

Petitioner stands implicated in murder.

Given the stage of the trial and the materials on record implicating the petitioner and the period of his detention, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

The application being **C.R.M. (DB) 2783 of 2024**
stands dismissed.
