CRM (NDPS) 1101 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Sagardighi Police Station Case No. 190 of 2025 dated 7th March, 2025 u/s 21(c)/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 corresponding to NDPS Case No. 45 of 2025.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated in connection with the instant case for alleged recovery of 46 bottles of phensedyl from his possession and he is in custody for about nine months.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is

Allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Rinku Sk @ Kala @ Kalu shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two

sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court under NDPS Act-cum- Additional Sessions Judge, 5th Court, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date of the trial so fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Murshidabad without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1101 of 2025 is **allowed**.
