Though the petitioner contends that the order dated 24th April, 2025 has not been complied with, it appears that WBSEDCL has discharged its responsibility by installing a meter at the relevant premises. It further appears that the petitioner has not effected the electricity connection from the main meter to his shop premises due to non-completion of the necessary electrical wiring.

The petitioner alleges that such wiring could not be carried out due to resistance from the promoters of the building. Respondent nos. 5 to 10, being the promoters, are not represented before this Court.

Let the affidavit of service filed by the petitioner be kept on record.

I find no justification to keep this writ petition pending. The petitioner is directed to carry out the necessary electrical wiring in the presence of police personnel deputed by the Officer-in-Charge of Bali Police Station. The petitioner shall bear the costs of such police assistance.

The petitioner shall intimate the Officer-in-Charge of Bali Police Station regarding the date on which he proposes to carry out the electrical wiring. On that date, the Officer-in-Charge shall depute the requisite number of police personnel at the relevant premises.

Accordingly, **WPA 21319 of 2025** stands disposed of.
