1. Court is informed that there is an amicable settlement between the de facto complainant and the petitioners.
2. Considering such fact and the materials in the case diary, we are inclined anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner no.1 shall report before the Investigating Officer as and when called for till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner no. 2 shall

cooperate with the investigation till its completion and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

4. Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.
5. **CRM (A)/3116/2024** is **disposed of**.
