Considering the serious nature of allegations and the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the statement of the minor victim, the statements of immediate post-occurrence witnesses who saw the petitioner and other accused fleeing away and the injury report, I do not consider that this is to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.
