In Re: CRAN 3 of 2025

1. All the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties to this application are present.
2. This instant application has been filed with a prayer for restoration of the revisional application being CRR 3686 of 2024 which was dismissed for default on 10.07.2025 for non-appearance of the petitioners.
3. Petitioner appearing in person submits that advocate-on-record was engaged in another bench, therefore he could not appear on call.
4. It is further submitted the explanation has been delineated in paragraph 4 of the application.

5. The revisional application was dismissed for default on 10.07.2025 and the instant application, being CRAN 3 of 2025 was filed on 14.07.2025.
