This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff and praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge, 1st Court, Junior Division at Barasat to dispose of an application under Order 7 Rule 11 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure filed in the Title Suit No. 975 of 2024 expeditiously.

Learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the defendant no. 1/opposite party no. 1 filed an application under Order 7 Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure praying for rejection of the plaint. She submits that the said application is otherwise ready for hearing and the written objection to the said application has already been filed.

Mr. Chakraborty, learned Advocate appears for the defendant no. 1/opposite party no. 1 herein.

From the order sheets appended to this application, this Court finds that September 23, 2025 has been fixed for hearing of the application under Order 7 Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
