1. Heard the submission of learned advocates appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as State.
2. The prayer of the petitioner is that other co-accused person is already granted bail dated August 13, 2025. However on the same date the prayer of the present petitioner is not considered by the same bench. Accordingly, bail application has been filed before this Court.
3. The Prosecution raised objection. However, considering the period of detention and charge-sheet has been submitted and the extent of complicity of the present petitioner in this case and also that the co-accused almost similarly circumstanced with the present petitioner, who is enlarged on bail, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Kalyani, Nadia and the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional

Court on the dates fixed for appearance and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court.

4. Thus, the application for bail in respect of petitioner is allowed.
5. Accordingly, the application being, **CRM(M) 1642 of 2025** stands disposed of as allowed.
