1. Father is before Court in this writ of habeas corpus seeking relief with regard to his daughter.

3. Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner in his usual fairness submits that, the petitioner received a phone call from the daughter stating that the daughter is unwilling to meet the petitioner or to take any assistance from the petitioner.
