In terms of the order dated September 11, 2025, the disability of the petitioner has been reassessed by the All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai (AIIPMR). A report of such assessment is produced before this Court in a sealed envelope.

The said certification center in its said assessment report dated September 15, 2025 certifies as follows:-

We, the undersigned members of the Medical Board, certify that the self certified affidavit submitted by the candidate has been assessed on defined functional competencies and found to be eligible for pursuing the MBBS course.”
