Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner be kept with the record.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved Assistant Teacher of a primary school who retired on February 28, 1992 and died on December 22, 2015.

The Pension Payment Order of the employee concerned was issued on March 09, 2000 in pursuance whereof the husband of the petitioner received the gratuity and the arrear pension on May15, 2000.

In the instant writ petition the prayer of the petitioner is a writ of mandamus be issued commanding the respondents to pay interest on the said amount of arrear pension and gratuity for the delayed payment.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay interest @ 8% per annum on the arrear amount of pension and gratuity from the date of retirement of the petitioner till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A 22413 of 2024 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
