In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Samsherganj Police Station case no. 727 of 2025 dated 09.07.2025 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated along with 400 bottles of cough syrup and he is in custody for more than five and half months. There is no possibility of the trial being concluded in near future, as such the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the chemical examination report has been received and very soon charge-sheet will be submitted before the jurisdictional Court.

Having considered that the investigation of the case is still in progress, at this stage I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1147 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
