The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that there is a typographical error in the order dated May 6, 2025. He submits that the direction was passed upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), 2nd Court at Serampore, Hooghly to make an endeavour to dispose of the Title Suit No. 555 of 2013 as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties. He submits that the direction should be passed upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division) at Serampore, Hooghly.

The expression “learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), 2nd Court at Serampore, Hooghly” shall be read as ‘learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division) at Serampore, Hooghly” in the order dated May 6, 2025.

Let such error be rectified and let this order form part of the order dated May 6, 2025.
