C.R.M. (NDPS) 1175 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Amdanga Police Station Case No. 613 of 2024 dated 04.09.2024 under Sections 20(b)(ii)(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was shown arrested for alleged recovery of 26 kgs. of ganja and since then, he is in custody for 1 year 3 months; charge-sheet has already been submitted and charges have been framed. However, there is no possibility of the trial concluding in near future. As such, petitioner prays for bail on any stringent condition.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that dilatory tactics is being adopted by the accused persons to protract the trial, although the prosecution has every intention to conclude the trial at the earliest.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am of the view that further detention of

the petitioner is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Rintu Mondal @ Batul** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court under the NDPS Act-cum-Additional Sessions Judge, 6th Court, Barasat.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of North 24-Parganas without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1175 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
