In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Paikar PS Case No.387/2025 dated 20.07.2025 under Sections 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/109/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary including the statements of witnesses and the injury report, which do not show inflicting of any grievous injury, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, the movement of the petitioner shall be restricted for a limited period.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the petitioner shall cooperate

with the investigation and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever and the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form shall and shall stay outside the jurisdiction of Paikar Police Station for a period of four months from this date except for meeting the Investigating Officer or attending the jurisdictional Court.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
