An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Marishda P.S. Case No.307 of 2025 dated 06.08.2025 under Section 103(1)/3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary and the alleged roles ascribed to the present petitioners while I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner Nos.2 and 3, the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner No.1 (Sudam Jana) is rejected.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner Nos.2 and 3 (Shashank Nayak and Ghanashayam Jana) shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and

on the further conditions that the petitioner Nos.2 and 3 shall cooperate with the investigation, shall meet the investigating officer once a week till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
