Learned advocate for the State has submitted that there are materials appearing against the present petitioner.

Learned advocate for the defacto-complainant is present.

I have perused the materials appearing in the case diary and, I am of the opinion that, at this stage, it would not be fit and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioners is **Rejected.**

Accordingly, CRM (M) 1777 of 2025 is **dismissed.**
