This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kakdwip, South 24 Parganas to dispose of Title Suit No. 83 of 2008 expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to issue notice upon the opposite party. However, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or upon the learned advocate representing the opposite parties before the learned trial judge.

In the light of the submissions made by the learned advocate for the petitioner, C.O. 3665 of 2025 stands disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kakdwip, South 24 Parganas to make an endeavour to dispose of Title Suit No. 83 of 2008 as expeditiously as possible but preferably within a period of twelve months from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

There shall be, however, no order as to costs.
