Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner earlier has submitted that another accused on the same footing has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Special Leave Petition (Crl.) no. 8895 of 2025.

Consequently, the present petitioner namely, **Swapan Kumar Biswas** be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as the trial Court deems fit and proper.
