It appears that the allegations under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act contain offensive acts committed in public view.

Therefore, the application for anticipatory bail would not lie.

Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is dismissed as not maintainable.
