CRM (NDPS) 1210 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Hogalberia Police Station case no. 194 of 2024 dated 18.08.2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the subject matter of the recovery in this case is 484 of bottles of phensedyl. However, the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused and is in custody for 235 days.

Learned advocate for the State has submitted a report. Report reflects that there have been no call data records or money trail and/or any antecedents of the present petitioner.

Having considered the totality of the circumstances, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

As such, petitioner namely, **Ushman Mondal @ Oshman Saik** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of

Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Nadia, Krishnagar.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed before the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of district of Nadia without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, the application for bail being CRM (NDPS) No. 1210 of 2025 is **allowed**.

Report submitted by the State be kept with the record.
