Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been detained on the accusations of recovery of 299 gm of heroine and is in custody for eleven months, as such, prays that on any stringent condition, the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that witness action has already been commenced.

Having considered the quantum of seizure, I am of the view that Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted, as such, I am not interested to release the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

However, the trial court is directed to ensure that the seizure list witnesses are examined within a period of 60

days from the next date so fixed before the learned trial court.

The petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the evidence of the seizure list witnesses are over.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1347 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
