In re : An Application for cancellation of bail under Section 439 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483(3) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Special S.T. Case No.22 of 2022 corresponding to FIR No.05 of 2021 under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 376(AB) and Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 whereby the accused/respondent no.2 was arbitrary granted bail.
