In Re: An Application for bail under section 439 (1)(b) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973/Section 483 (1) (b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Falta Police Station Case No. 47 of 2025 dated 07.03.2025 under Sections 85/103(1)/238 of the BNS, 2023.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 252 days and has been falsely implicated in connection with the instant case as there are materials to show that the victim/deceased left the in-laws house and had been residing at her parental house. However, there are no materials to connect the present petitioner so far as the incidents leading towards the death of the deceased and the police authorities unnecessarily on flimsy grounds have resorted to a matrimonial dispute for implicating the present petitioner.

Learned advocate appearing for the State has submitted the case diary.

I have perused the materials appearing therein particularly with regard to the C.C.T.V. footage of the petrol pump and the place of occurrence. Having considered the same, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 1919 of 2025 is dismissed.

Learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the process of consideration of charges and trial.
