CRM (M) 1934 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Shasan Police Station Case No. 210 of 2024 dated 15.09.2024 under Sections 65(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for one year two months and only one witness has been examined till date. As such, learned advocate for the petitioner prays that on any stringent condition petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State has produced the Case Dairy.

I have considered the materials available, particularly the medical documents and I am of the view that this is not a fit case for considering the prayer advanced by the petitioner.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 1934 of 2025 is dismissed.

However, the learned trial Court would consider the detention of the petitioner and take steps so that the trial is expedited.
