**C.R.M. (NDPS) 1283 of 2025**

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Dhubuliya Police Station Case No. 99 of 2024 dated 04.03.2024 under Sections 21(c)/25/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the prosecution case accuses the petitioner along with others for illegal possession of 7500 bottles of Phensedyl. The present petitioner is in custody for 1 year 10 months and only one witness, out of the proposed 11 witnesses, has been examined by the prosecution. Petitioner prays for bail on any stringent condition.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that huge volume of contraband has been recovered. It has also been submitted that the petitioner is thickly connected with the alleged offence and release of the petitioner would jeopardize the trial.

I have taken into account the submissions of the learned advocates and I am of the view that the petitioner has failed to overcome the rigors of Section 37 of the NDPS Act. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

State is directed to conclude the examination of the seizure list witnesses preferably within a period of three months from the next date so fixed.

Petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after the examination of seizure list witnesses is over.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1283 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
