After perusal of the order dated 9th October, 2012 passed by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 12th Court, Calcutta, it reveals that the accused persons, namely, Priyojit Basu and Birendra Roy, respectively were not found guilty under Sections 353/114 of the IPC, thereby acquitted them from the said case under Section 255(1) Cr.P.C. and also discharged from their bail bond and set at liberty.
2. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the instant revisional application has become infructuous.
