CRM (NDPS) 1310 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Lalgola Police Station case no. 124 of 2025 dated 12.02.2025 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that he has been arraigned for alleged recovery of 260 grams of heroin and is in custody for 10 months. There is no possibility of the trial concluding in near future, as such petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State on the other hand opposes the prayer for bail and submits that charges have been framed and witness action would commence.

Having regard to the quantity of contraband seized, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

As such, prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1310 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

However, State is directed to complete the examination of seizure list witnesses within a period of 60 days from the next date so fixed before the learned trial Court.

Petitioner would renew his prayer for bail after the said period of over.
