CRM (NDPS) 1315 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Sankrail Police Station case no. 38 of 2024 dated 13.01.2024 under Sections 20(b)(ii)(c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been detained in custody on the accusations of recovery of 41 kg of ganja and she is in custody for about two years. It is further submitted that till date none of the witnesses have been examined and there is no possibility of the trial concluding in near future.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the materials appearing and is of the opinion that the provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.

As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1315 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

However, State is directed to take steps so that within a period of 60 days from the next date so fixed seizure list witnesses are examined.

Petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the aforesaid period is over.
