Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 1 year 9 months and the trial of the case is at the very inception. As such, on any stringent condition, petitioner prays for bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that 7500 bottles of Phensedyl were recovered.

Having considered the stage of the case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

State is directed to examine the seizure list witnesses within a period of sixty days from the next date so fixed before the learned Trial Court.

Petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after the examination of seizure list witnesses is over.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1326 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
