The petitioner filed this application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging the order dated 25th September, 2025 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 5th Court at Alipore in Title Suit no. 1548 of 2025 as well as pray for expeditious disposal of the application for interim injunction in accordance with law.
