An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Suti Police Station Case No.977 of 2025 dated 12.08.2025 under Sections 305(A)/3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It has been alleged in the FIR that taking advantage of absence of the de facto complainant, the petitioner and others simply came into their house and took away **from their showcase** fifty bhories of gold ornaments and cash of Rs.25 lakhs.

It appears that no notice was given to the petitioner.

Considering the above and the other materials available in the case diary, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, one of

whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on the further conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation, shall meet the investigating officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
