In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Palashipara** P.S. Case No.**342 of 2025** dated **18.07.2025** under Sections **115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/303(2)/329(3)/351(2)/76/3(5)** of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary including the statements of the victims and the injury report showing dislocation of shoulder, the alleged roles ascribed to each of petitioners and the fact that there are allegations and counter allegations, while I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner nos. 1, 2, 4 and 5, the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner no. 3 (Sadhak Biswas @ Mrigan Biswas) is rejected.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner Nos. 1 (Milon Biswas), 2 (Mregash Biswas @ Mrigesh Biswas), 4 (Samar Biswas) and 5 (Mirmadan Biswas) shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of

whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner Nos. 1, 2, 4 and 5 shall cooperate with investigation and shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight till submission of report in final form, shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses and shall stay outside the jurisdiction of Palashipara P.S. for a period of two months from this date except for meeting the I.O. or attending the jurisdictional Court.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
