The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of Matrimonial Suit No. 1886 of 2023, pending before the learned Additional District Judge, 5th Court, Barasat.

The prayer of the petitioner is innocuous. Neither party stands to lose if a proceeding is disposed of expeditiously. In fact, such expeditious disposal shall enure to the benefit of the parties.

The revisional application is disposed of with a request to the learned court to dispose of the said suit preferably within one year from the next date fixed. Adequate opportunity shall be granted to the parties to contest the same.

This court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the suit. The learned court shall proceed independently and in accordance with law.
