The Petitioner is an Assistant Teacher at Jharapara Primary School, a school under the D.P.S.C., Jhargram, the respondent no.5 herein.

The petitioner is praying for a general transfer on the ground of distance and is a surplus teacher of his school.

The representation of the petitioner dated 22nd July, 2024, is pending consideration before the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education, the respondent no.4 herein. The said representation forms part of the writ petition, being Annexure 'P-5'.

The respondent no.4 is directed to consider and dispose of the said representation in accordance with

law within 10 weeks from the date of communication of this order of this Court to respondent no.4.

WPA 25180 of 2024 is disposed of with the above terms without any order as to costs.
