Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary, the fact that the petitioner has, as many as two other criminal antecedents involving the NDPS Act and the restriction contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The application for anticipatory bail being **CRM (A) 3663 of 2025** is, thus, rejected.
