CRM (NDPS) 1464 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Gangarampur PS Case No. 83 of 2024 dated 27.02.2024 under sections 21(c)/22(c)/23(c)/27A/28/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (corresponding to NDPS Case No. 12 of 2024).**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that he has been implicated in connection with the instant case on the basis of statement of a co-accused and there has been no recovery from the possession of the present petitioner.

Learned advocate also submits that the subject-matter of the case relates to seizure of 75 bottles of phensedyl.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have considered the factum that there has been no seizure from the present petitioner, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Noor Islam @ Nur Islam shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge (under NDPS Act), Balurghat, Dakshin Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall make himself physically available on each and every date of the trial so fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1464 of 2025 is **allowed**.
