C.R.M. (NDPS) 1392 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Sagarpara Police Station Case No. 412 of 2024 dated 11.10.2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than a year and similarly placed accused has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Criminal Appeal No. 4582 of 2025.

Learned advocate appearing for the State is not in a position to distinguish the parity between the present petitioner and the petitioner who has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Apex Court.

Having considered the same, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Aidul Sk.** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with

two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

If on bail, the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Murshidabad and shall make himself available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Trial Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1392 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
