An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Daspur Police Station Case No.144 of 2025 dated 31.03.2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/76/351(2)/3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a free fight between neighbours. The first FIR was started from the side of the petitioner. A similarly circumstanced co-accused being the father of the present petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and refers to the statement of eyewitness as also the injury report, which shows lacerated injury on scalp requiring stitches and medical treatment at the hospital.

Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
