1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. It is alleged that the application filed by the petitioner seeking transfer on medical ground is pending consideration at the end of the school authority.
3. It appears that a no-objection by the school was issued in favour of the petitioner; but thereafter the school did not take any further step to forward the transfer application to the next appropriate authority.
4. In view thereof, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the school authority to take steps for forwarding the application for transfer of the petitioner to the competent authority in accordance with law at the earliest but positively within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

5. The respondents shall ensure that the petitioner's application for transfer reaches its logical conclusion without any further delay.
