Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is detained in custody since 28th February, 2025. The
accusations are for recovery of 580 grams of heroin.

Pursuant to the earlier direction, State has submitted the

respect of the cognizance taken by the learned special court.

Having considered that the trial court records are not

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1409 of 2025 is dismissed.
