Report filed by the State is taken on record. It contains the subsequent statement of the victim recorded before learned Magistrate.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary including the statements of the victim recorded before the learned Magistrate and other witnesses and the injury report and the alleged roles ascribed to the present petitioners, while I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner

No.1, the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner No.2 (Magfera Bibi @ Magfera Begam) is rejected.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner No.1 (Abdus Sukur) shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on the further conditions that the petitioner No.1 shall cooperate with the investigation, shall meet the investigating officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
