1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today be taken on record.
2. This writ petition is premature. It is noticed that the petitioner has made a representation before the respondent No. 3 on October 27, 2025 and filed this writ petition on November 7, 2025 alleging inaction on the part of the respondent no. 3 in taking steps on the basis of such representation, as would be evident from paragraph 6 of the writ petition.
3. In such view of the matter, no mandatory order can be passed in this writ petition.
4. **WPA 25229 of 2025** is **disposed of** with the above observations.
5. The respondent No. 3 shall, however, be free to take appropriate decision on the petitioner's representation made before it, in accordance with law.
